The first team won a bench trial against U.S. Customs concerning improper tariffs levied against our client's importation of a revolutionary HIV drug. The second team reached a record-breaking settlement on the eve of closing arguments, following a two-week jury trial, on behalf of the estate of an incarcerated person who died in a New York State prison.

In addition to his work as a commercial litigator, Mr. Eisenberg serves on the Monitoring Team for the Newark Police Division, which is responsible for overseeing the Newark Police's compliance with a Consent Decree of police reforms with the U.S. Department of Justice. He also represents non-profit organizations, such as museums and charities, in connection with government investigations, and advises large institutions on compliance with U.S. sanctions law.
